

Piercing FAQs:

- **How old do I have to be to get a piercing?**

- Minors can only be pierced with parental consent and the proper documentation.
- Legally, you must be at least 18 years of age with a valid state ID, driver's license, or passport to get a piercing as an adult. We cannot use Military ID due to federal law (Title 18, U.S. Code Part I, Chapter 33, Section 701).

- **What do I need if I'd like to bring my child to get pierced?**

- For minors, we require the minor's birth certificate along with the parent present and the parent's ID.
- In the event the parent has a different last name and/or address from the child, court documentation is needed to prove the relationship, i.e., divorce papers, or a remarriage certificate.
- Please keep in mind that we have different restrictions on which piercings are available for minors and at what age.

- **What jewelry do you pierce with?**

- We only carry implant-grade jewelry and offer options in white, yellow, and rose gold, titanium, which can be anodized in a variety of different colours, and niobium, which can be anodized in different colours as well as opalescent and black. We have gorgeous mirror-polish classic pieces, and also pieces with precious and semiprecious gemstones and genuine diamonds.
